The Gelardin New Media Center empowers the Georgetown University community to teach, learn, publish, and communicate in new and innovative ways. Our experienced training staff, state-of-the-art facility, and vast multimedia collection provide the necessary resources to share ideas and research through expressive digital projects.



## Instruction & Consultation

We offer a variety of services that help Georgetown faculty use technology to enhance their teaching and productivity, and increase digital literacy among students. Our staff works with faculty to evaluate technology platforms, tools, and assignments to decide which are most appropriate to reach course learning goals. When partnering with faculty to support a course assignment, we can provide high-impact technology instruction to professors and students, helping them



learn to communicate and design effectively using multimedia tools, while keeping the focus on course content.

## Equipment

Our production equipment ranges from basic, easy-to-use gear, to full professional setups, for video, audio, photography, and computing. Production equipment can be checked out for a 24-hour loan period. We also circulate iPads and Kindle Fire tablets for a loan period of two weeks. Two iPads are available for semester-long loan to faculty who are interested in using them in their instruction and/or research. Please contact us for more information.



## Collections

Our media collection is interdisciplinary and international in scope and includes more than 20,000 video titles and 7,000 CDs. The Georgetown University Library also provides instant online access to several thousand streaming media titles. Faculty can place course media on reserve and we can provide online access to the materials via our secure streaming server.



## Spaces

The Gelardin New Media Center has several state-of-the-art computing, instruction and production studios. Please see our website for more information about our spaces.



Our **General Computing Area** is open nearly 24/7, and has more than 60 PC workstations for research, word processing, printing, and scanning.

The **Picchi Multimedia Room** has 12 student Mac workstations and an instructor station, and hosts many of our workshops and classes. When no meetings are scheduled, these workstations are available for walk-in use.

Our **Multimedia Group Co-LABoratory (CoLab)** is a high-tech, flexible work space that provides a collaborative environment for groups or classes working on creative projects, giving presentations, or viewing videos.



We have eight **Editing Suites** that offer professional-quality equipment and software for a variety of digital projects.

Our **Production Studio** is our largest recording space, with high-quality audio and video equipment, green-screen capability, and a separate control room.
