If not, consider whether fair use would apply or reformat the data into your own chart, table, or graph. If you reformat data, provide a complete citation to the original source.</p>	<p>Data is not protected under copyright law; charts, tables, and graphs that present data in a non-creative manner may be used freely.</p> <p>If the data is presented in a creative manner, check the copyright status to see if it is public domain or open access. If not, reformat the data into your own chart, table, or graph, consider whether fair use would apply, or request permission from the publisher. If you reformat data, provide a complete citation to the original source.</p>
